## Thrill Mountain

Take the leap from a 40-meter platform into the canyon, glide through awe-inspiring valleys on our ziplines, traverse our magnificent Nepalese bridge. Your safety is our utmost priority, and all of our facilities and equipment strictly adhere to EU requirements.



### 400m Zipline

This one is dedicated to the adventurous. Get ready to rush on one of the longest ziplines of Mauritius and soar into the air! Feel the wind like never before as you slide down the legendary 400m zipline! And afterwards, zig-zag across four ziplines for a sensational experience!

### Nepalese Bridge and 5 Ziplines

Enjoy a delicious breakfast on the giraffe platform surrounded by centenarian trees and accompanied by these gentle creatures.

### Rhino Interaction

If you have always dreamt of seeing a rhino up close, here is your chance. Ella & Benji, the two white rhinos of Casela are really playful and friendly. This interaction is done early in the morning from 8:30 to 9:15 in their enclosure before they are released in the African Safari. You will get to pat and feed them as well as learn a lot about their species.



## TERMS & CONDITIONS

In order to ensure that your visit to 'Casela World of Adventures' is an enjoyable one, we kindly request that all visitors to respect the following terms and conditions:

### 1. SECURITY

For security reasons, Casela reserves the right to check the contents of your personal belongings. Should you refuse, you may be asked to leave the premises or refused entrance to the Park, without any refund/indemnity. Although security cameras may be installed in or around the Park, Casela cannot be responsible for any loss, damage and/or theft of your personal belongings.

### 2. PERSONAL BELONGINGS

Unless required for medical reasons (any proof of which must be provided to Casela), it shall be forbidden to enter the Park with any vehicle or equipment (whether motorized or non-motorized), usually used for transporting any object or person, including but not limited to, rollerblades, roller skates, scooters, bicycles, etc.

Voluminous and/or heavy baggage are not permitted in the Park for security reasons. You may be required to leave the baggage at the entrance of any ride and/or attraction, at your own risk, before embarking.

It shall be forbidden to bring into the Park, any illegal substances, alcohol, glass bottles and/or containers, balls, balloons, firearms and/or generally any other object which, is likely to be offensive, dangerous and/or is illegal.

Casela shall not be responsible for any loss, damage and/or theft of your personal belongings. Visitor's personal belongings must not be left unattended. Any unclaimed personal belongings left in the Park, at the end of a working day, shall be disposed of by Casela as it may deem fit. Visitors are advised not to bring any valuable items into the Park. Since some of the attractions may be bumpy and dusty, visitors are advised to protect and hold on well to their personal belongings.

### 3. CLOTHING AND FOOTWEAR

A decent, proper and appropriate dress code must be respected, such as, but not limited to, shirts, t-shirts, jeans, pants, and/or shorts. Footwear must be worn at all times. Closed or fastened shoes must be worn for canyoning and zipline activities.

Casela reserves the right to request a visitor to temporarily remove any mask they may be wearing, as required by the law or for medical reasons (any other types of mask shall be prohibited), for identification or security purposes.

Casela reserves the right to refuse access to any visitor, or request any visitor to leave the Park, without refund or indemnity, where the visitor has not followed the dress code.

### 4. CHILDREN AND BABIES

Children under 12 years must be accompanied by an adult at all times. Any unaccompanied child will be refused access to rides/attractions.

Any disclaimer forms shall be signed by the legal guardian of any visitors under the age of 18 prior his/her participation in any rides and/or attractions, failing which, they shall be refused access/ participation.

Pushchairs and prams are permitted, provided that they do not prevent or unreasonably obstruct the passage of visitors of the park in the alleyways/paths. Given the natural landscape and topography of the Park, pushchairs may be difficult to use in some areas. Casela's staff may assist, when necessary and where possible.

Certain rides and/ or attractions may be unsuitable for small children. If in doubt, please enquire with a member of staff for more information. The legal guardian of any minor visitors/participants shall be liable for any damage and/or injury caused by the minor.

Baby changing facilities are available at the 'Discovery Centre' of the Park.

## 5. HEALTH, PREGNANCY AND FIRST AID FACILITIES

All visitors have a duty to inform Casela of any medical condition prior to participating in any of the proposed activities.

All visitors have a duty to check their state of health before entering the Park and take cognizance of all information, signs and/or brochures communicated prior to participating in any rides and/or attractions.

Visitors suffering from epilepsy and/or sensitivity to camera flashes are advised not to participate in any ride or attraction with photoshoots.

It is strictly prohibited to participate in certain rides and attractions whilst pregnant.

Casela shall not be liable in case of any accidents that may happen during the activity due to the non-disclosure or concealment of important medical information, including pregnancies, or of the visitor's negligence.

Casela reserves the right to refuse participation, without any refund and/or indemnity, in any rides and/or attractions due to any medical and/or security reasons. Upon such refusal, a more suitable activity cannot be guaranteed as an alternative.

Emergency first aid kits are available at all retail outlets. Most of Casela's staff are trained in first aid. Emergency services will be contacted by Casela where required.

## 6. ACTS AND BEHAVIOUR

A visitor shall not harass others or misbehave in a manner that causes disruption or obstruction to the peaceful enjoyment of the Park by visitors and the community of animals found there in. Anyone undertaking such behaviour or act will be asked to leave the premises, without refund/indemnity and may be the subject of a criminal enquiry, where the matter is reported to the Police.

Any unauthorised interaction with the animals is strictly forbidden.

It is a criminal offence to any animal, plant, part of the landscape and/or any other structure remove from the Park, and/or to damage or deface any of the aforesaid.

## 7. HEIGHT RESTRICTIONS

Height restrictions, indicated and applicable for certain rides and attractions must be respected, for safety purposes.

## 8. EATING AND/OR DRINKING

In order to ensure the safety of the animals of the Park, it shall be forbidden for the visitors to feed the animals, unless as part of an activity and under the supervision of a member of Casela's staff.

Any food and drink purchased within the Park must be consumed within the designated zones, i.e. restaurants and picnic areas.

It shall be forbidden to bring any outside food and drink into the Park, unless required for medical purposes (proof of which shall be provided to Casela) or for infant children.

## 9. SMOKING AND ALCOHOL

No smoking or other use of tobacco products (including, but not limited to cigarettes, e-cigarettes or vaping devices, pipes, cigars, snuff, or chewing tobacco) is permitted within the Park (including but not limited to its vehicles, parking areas and indoor/outdoor areas), except at the designated smoking areas.

Alcoholic beverages can only be consumed within the restaurants of the Park, which are duly licensed for the sale and consumption of alcohol. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited in all other parts of the Park and recreation areas.

## 10. ENTRANCE AND RE-ADMISSION

Entrance to the Park shall only be permitted where:

- a. The tickets are paid upon arrival; or
  - b. The tickets have been prepaid; or
  - c. The bookings are agreed to by Casela, through means of an “Order Confirmation Statement” and upon the issue of a voucher by Casela and/or the tour operator, where applicable, for the booking. The aforesaid voucher or voucher number must be presented upon arrival at the Park, failing which, entry shall be refused.
- Any person leaving the Park, shall only be allowed to re-enter the Park after paying for a new ticket. The activities included in the entrance ticket, which do not require any specific booking, are available on a first come, first serve basis. Visitors may be required to queue.

All visitors must enter the ‘Discovery Centre’ through the main entrance. Visitors are requested to exit the Park through the ‘Safira Shop’ in the ‘Discovery Centre’.

It shall be forbidden to linger in or on the premises after public opening hours of the Park, as may be communicated through the website of Casela.

## 11. ANIMALS

No animals shall be brought into the Park by visitors, apart from guide dogs. The owner of any guide dog will bear all responsibility for the acts and doings of the latter.

It shall be strictly forbidden for any person to ill-treat any animals in the Park.

All visitors must adhere strictly to any security protocols and directives of the guides, during any controlled interactions with animals, especially before touching and/or approaching any animal.

It is a criminal offence to remove any animals from the Park.

Any unauthorised interaction with the animals is strictly forbidden.

## 12. HAWKING AND UNAUTHORISED COMMERCIAL ACTIVITIES

Hawking and/or the sale and/or distribution of any items/brochures/questionnaires within the Park and/or parking areas are strictly forbidden.

## 13. PHOTOS/VIDEOS

Any photos and/or videos taken by visitors within the Park (unless otherwise permitted by Casela in writing), shall be used solely for personal purposes and not for any commercial purpose.

## 14. WEATHER CONDITIONS

In the event of adverse weather conditions, certain activities may be cancelled and/or suspended by Casela for security reasons. In such event, no refund will be made and visitors will be accommodated in the next available activities on the same day, if possible.

Certain activities/ rides/ attractions maybe conducted, even during rainy weather. Should a visitor choose not to participate in those activities/ rides/ attractions during rainy weather, a 100% cancellation fee (i.e. total cost of booking) shall be applied.

## 15. PUNCTUALITY

Visitors are requested to ensure that they arrive at the:

- a) Park at least 45 minutes before the start of their booked activity;
- b) Designated waiting area 15 minutes before the start of the activity to be picked up by the guides and transported to the relevant departure points.

If a visitor is late and misses the activity, Casela cannot guarantee an available place in the next or subsequent scheduled slots on the same day. In any circumstance, no refund will be made.

## 16. BIG CATS ACTIVITIES – SPECIAL CONDITIONS

All visitors are made aware that the 'Big Cats' activities, i.e. activities with lions, tigers, etc., are provided by Safari Adventures Ltd and not directly by Casela Limited. Casela Limited assists Safari Adventures Ltd in the booking of the 'Big Cats' activities.

The walk with lions lasts for about 45 minutes to 1 hour. Visitors are advised to cater for at least 20 minutes of shuttle time to reach the waiting area of any activities booked prior to or after the walk with lions.

Visitors should ideally cater for 1 hour 45 minutes in the event that they choose a walk with lions, plus an interaction with lions.

The whole 'Big Cat' area of the Park is closed daily between 12.30 p.m. and 13.30 p.m. for lunch.

Visitors are advised to contact Casela to enquire on the days and times at which the 'Big Cats' activities are available.

Visitors shall sign a disclaimer form before taking part in the following 'Big Cats' activities:

- a) Interaction;
- b) Walk with Lions;
- c) Drive-thru – lions and tigers.

A visitor under the age of 18 ("Minor") must be accompanied by their legal guardian, at all times. The legal guardian shall sign the disclaimer form on behalf of the Minor.

There is a height restriction of a minimum of 1m 50cm for 'Big Cats' activities, with an exception for observation and drive thru.

A Minor who wishes to participate in the walk with the lions must:

- a) be at least 15 years old (proof of which must be provided to Casela, failing which, participation shall be denied without refund or indemnity); and
- b) Meet the height restriction of a minimum of 1m 50cm.

Visitors with a disability, either physical or mental, shall not be allowed to participate in the walk or interaction with lions, for safety reasons.

Persons under the influence of alcohol will not be considered fit to participate in any of the activities.

Visitors participating in the Activities should be fluent in either English, French or Mauritian Creole. In the contrary, the visitors must be accompanied by a translator, at their own costs or at the cost of their tour operator. Casela must be informed beforehand where a visitor will be accompanied by a translator.

Where a visitor, who does not speak English, French or Mauritian Creole, and is not accompanied by a translator, wishes to book an activity, requiring a safety talk before, during or after the activity, Casela reserves the right to refuse the booking or participation of the visitor for that activity.

If the visitor does not fulfil the height, age and/or health requirement, no refunds will be applied. Tour operators have a specific duty to ensure that the visitors meet the criteria for participating in the activities.

If the visitor chooses to not participate in the activity once at the 'Big Cats' zone, he/she shall not be eligible for a refund.

Should the visitor choose not to participate in the activity on the booked date, on medical grounds, he will not be eligible for a refund, unless he/she presents a medical certificate.

In the eventuality of rainy weather, all visitors participating in the 'walk with the lions' activity will be offered a rain coat in order to proceed with the activity. Where the activity is maintained, during rainy weather, but the visitor chooses to not participate, a 100% cancellation fee (i.e. total cost of booking) shall be applied.

A postponement may be considered in case of extreme rainfall.

Visitors should arrive at the Park at least 45 minutes before the departure time for the walk with lions. Late arrivals will not be refunded. However, the visitors may be offered an interaction with lions as an alternative, if available.

Visitors are advised to wear appropriate footwear, such as sports shoes, tennis, trainers, etc., during the walk with lions as the ground is uneven. Flip flops are not recommended, especially during rainy seasons.

Participants are advised not to wear any sunglasses unless absolutely necessary by prescription. Sun cream and mosquito repellent may be worn.

## 17. BASIC SAFETY RULES FOR BIG CATS ACTIVITIES

Visitors are hereby advised that during the 'Big Cats' Activities, they should not:

- a) shout or scream;
- b) run;
- c) sit (unless requested to do so);
- d) wear sunglasses.

During the Big Cats Activities, visitors should remain in the group at ALL times and turn off all mobile phones.

All visitors have a duty to inform the guide of any medical condition prior to participating in any of the 'Big Cats' Activities.

Visitors should only approach animals when clearly instructed to do so by the guide or handler.

Visitors should only approach animals in the area that the guide or handler has requested them to do so.

Visitors MUST NOT touch the head of the animal.

Each visitor will be provided with a walking stick, which should remain with them throughout the activity.

For their own safety, visitors must adhere to all instructions given by the guide.

The 'Big Cats' Activities may be stopped/cancelled, at any point in time, at the discretion of the guide or handler.

During the walk and/or interactions with lions, all personal items will be locked away securely.

Unreasonable behaviour shall not be tolerated and Casela reserves the right to remove any such participants from the activity and/or the Park.

All visitors must abide with any other safety measures or instructions displayed within the Park or communicated to them by Casela's staff. Visitors who do not comply with the safety measures or instructions will be asked to leave the Park, without any refund and/or indemnity.

Emergency Procedures:

In the unlikely event of an accident, visitors are reassured that our guides and the management are trained in advanced first aid. Emergency Response Services are also readily available with the Park.

## 18. CANCELLATION

A 100% cancellation fee (i.e. total cost of booking) shall apply in the event that the guest (where applicable):

- does not show up 30 minutes prior to the start of the Activity;
- cancels the booking by email, fax or phone, on the day of the Activity;
- cancels the booking within less than 24 hours prior to the date of the Activity/ booking;
- cancels the booking of the Activities upon arrival at the Park or at the departure point.

Please note that no confirmed bookings can be exchanged for other activities.

The Management of Casela reserves the right to suspend or cancel any Activity and/or booking, and/or close the park for the following reasons:

- the safety and security of its visitors;
- the proper running of the Park;
- adverse weather conditions;
- power failure;
- maintenance and/or construction;
- the minimum number of participants has not been obtained;
- the participant is unfit to participate in the activity

In such an event, Casela shall, where possible, accommodate the visitors in the next available Activities on the same day or provide a refund.
