


Le Pouce Hike



Noticeable from a distance, based on its form looking like a thumb. The Pouce mountain will bring us to a height of 812 meters and will provide you with a view of the capital city and expanding village of St Pierre.

From up top, the view of the Moka ranges and some of the islets north of the island give back the true origin of Mauritius; being volcanic.

08:30 – Meeting at Le Pouce mountain parking at Petit Verger

Trips start with a briefing and some safety measures.

Then walk through the village of La Laura before starting the ascent to Le Pouce mountain.

About 1 hour 30 minutes of hike before reaching the peak of Le Pouce, where you will have a 360° view of Mauritius for some magnificent pictures.

Long sleeve t-shirt (should avoid cotton), bring along a rain coat, shorts in summer, breathable pants (avoid denim), woolen socks, rain pants.

Terms and Conditions

- No refund for pre-booked confirmed tour when guests cancel in Mauritius
